The Royal Charter incorporated the Society in July 1984. This code of conduct is directed to all members of The British Computer Society. As an aid to understanding, these rules have been grouped into the principal duties, which all members should endeavour to discharge in pursuing their professional lives.

Code of Conduct - As examples, relevant legislation could, in the UK, include The UK Public Disclosure Act, Data Protection or Privacy legislation, Computer Misuse law, legislation concerned with the export or import of technology, possibly for national security reasons, or law relating to intellectual property.
